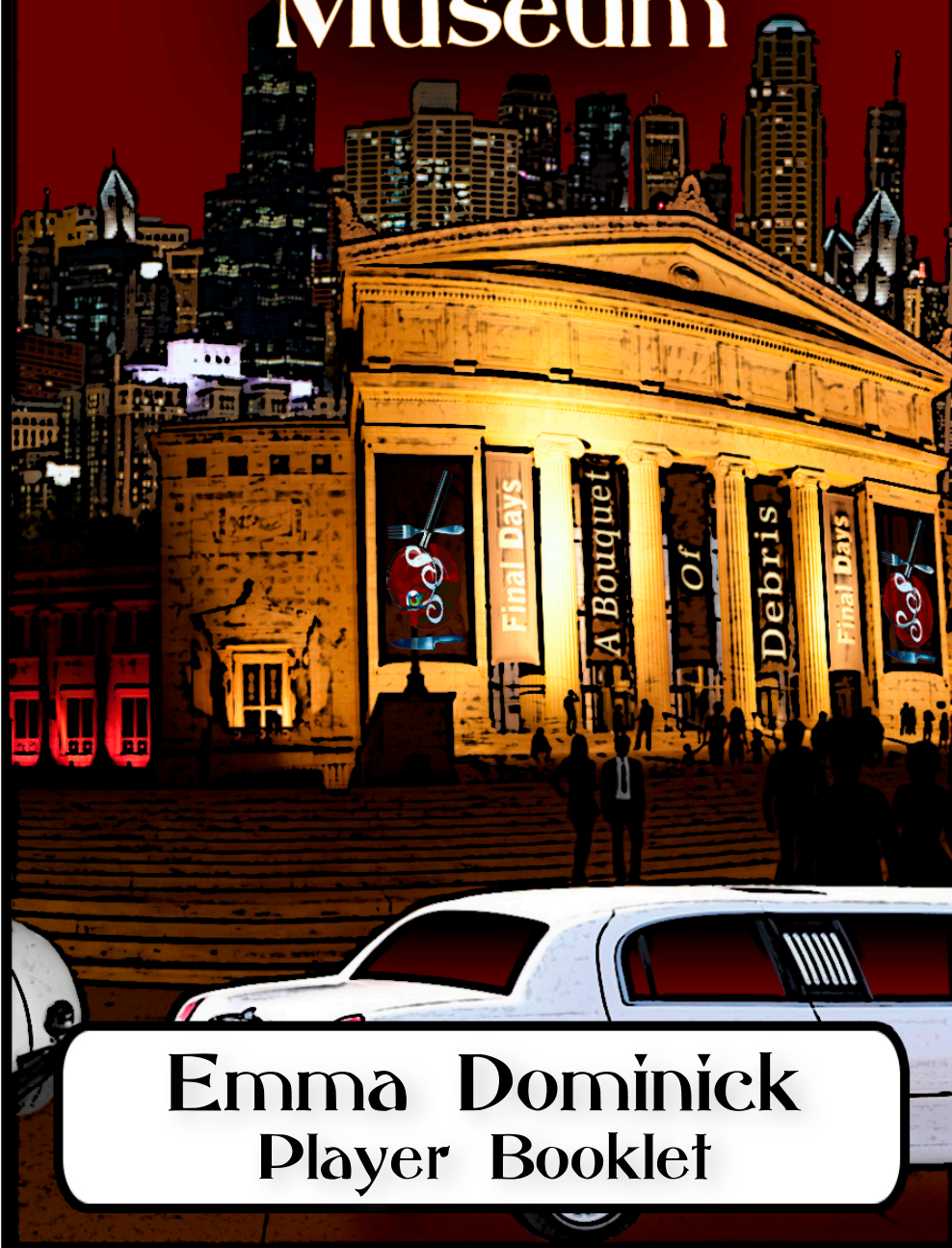

Player Booklet and Secret Clue

How to Play the Game

This room is full of murder suspects – and you are one of them! You must try to figure out who the murderer is tonight, by both accusing your fellow players and also trying to convince everyone else that you are innocent.

This game has four rounds, each round revealing new pieces of information about each character. Do not turn the page in your player's booklet until the host tells you to do so.

On the left side of each page is information you are to share with the whole group. You can either ad lib or read directly from the page, but make sure that before moving on to the next round, you share all information on the left side of each page with the whole group.

On the right side of the page, you will see hidden information about your character. Do not reveal this information unless you are directly questioned about it. You may not lie if someone asks you about this information, but you do not need to offer incriminating evidence about yourself without a direct question. However, if you find out that you are the murderer, and someone asks you directly whether you are the murderer, then you should say, "I am not aware of that information at this time".

If someone asks you a question you do not know the answer to, say, "I am not aware of that information at this time". The murderer is the only one permitted to lie at any time in this game.

There are also 8 secret clues that different players will reveal throughout the night. Make sure you do not look at your clue until your player's booklet tells you to look at it and pass it around to the group. You may use the next page to take notes throughout the evening.

At the start of the game, the killer is not aware of his or her identity – it could even be you! Be suspicious of everyone's motives, and remain in character throughout the evening. After dessert, you will be given a chance to make your accusation. You may accuse any player of being the killer, including yourself. However, you must give evidence from the clues, and DO NOT tell anyone if the booklet says you are the killer! Have fun!

The Characters (all are suspects)

Mark Chase – Raphaëla’s boyfriend and an up-and-coming in the world of architecture, Mark is a sophisticated and worldly man. However, when he’s under the pressure of a deadline, he may not always play fair.

Ramie Palleta – Sister to Raphaella, Ramie is a martial artist who looks for very creative ways to release anger. An art show might be the perfect place.

Eddie Grayson – A student at the university where Raphaëla teaches, Eddie is a talented young man who has been her protégée. Her work seems to tirelessly consume Eddie's vivid personality, but what are the limits to this obsession?

Jim Hall -Head security guard at the Rall Museum, Jim both haunts the corridors and taunts the patrons of the museum constantly. He is talkative tonight, but knowing the museum so well gives him lots of room for secrets.

Michaela Gelato - As Raphaela's biggest competitor in the art world, Michaela is a dazzling and rare woman of talent and class. She's suspicious of anyone whose art is exceptional but could she also be desperate enough to sabotage?

Jasmine Lipton – Ms. Lipton is a well-known benefactress, art collector, and cat lover. She has put forth thousands in support of Raphaëla’s work and tonight’s unveiling may mean more to her than meets the eye.

Tip Wright – A sportswriter for the city’s biggest newspaper, everyone is stunned that Tip ended up at the Rall for an art show. How Tip reads into tonight’s show is critical, considering his words are going to be splashed over the city tomorrow.

Emma Dominick – Emma is the beautiful and stylish art director at the museum, and is emceeing the art show. Friends with Raphaella since college, Emma’s judgment has always meant the world to her. How that judgment will fall tonight remains to be seen

Share this information with the group after Michaela:

Soup/Salad

Share this information with the group after Ramie Palleta:

You are mad underneath, not just because Raphie accused you of things all of the time, but because she was usually right. You did steal them. They'll look just fabulous in your apartment, too.

Main Course

Share this after Edward accuses you and Mark:

Edward, I know you're trying to get yourself out of trouble, but I am sorry to tell you that trouble is still clearly painted all over your own face. And Tip, I want no mention, (wink) of this in any gossip columns, ok? It would be just too much of a shock for my colleagues and friends to think that I was involved with such a prestigious man. Unless you absolutely have to of course. But Edward, I truly don't think you have much of a connection. Just because I'm friends with Mark, doesn't mean I murdered my best friend. Share this information with the group first, before anyone else:

I've taken the liberty of printing up this email to show the group just how close Raphie actually was to this girl. (Show the group your clue.) Could you be trying to take revenge for the years of heartache your sister Raphie caused you? I know she certainly would have had my blood boiling after years of sisterly torment. Being her best friend was hard enough!

**Hidden Information:
(Do not share until you feel it's necessary.)**

If anyone asks you how Ramie treated Raphie generally, you must admit that even though Raphie told you about the cruel things she had done to her sister at times, she always gave petty reasons for doing so. In fact, you have always felt sorry for Ramie putting up with her. However, you need the heat off of yourself and will do anything to make sure someone else is blamed for tonight's fiasco.
